*In This privacy statement we explain for which purpose (s) we collect and use your personal data. You can read below why we process personal data from prospects, members, directors, visitors to our website and other affiliates. We indicate how long we keep your personal data. Depending on your capacity you can read below what applies to you.*

### **For prospects (Potential members of the association)**

*When you have provided us with your personal data for a possible membership, we will use your personal information to inform you about the Association and membership. This is necessary to enable you to enter into any membership with us. We see this membership as an ' agreement ' between you and the association within the meaning of the general data Protection regulation. If you are not interested in this, all your data will be deleted.*

### **For members of the Association**

#### **Entering into and executing membership**

*The Personal data you provide us we will collect and use. Because this is necessary to register as a member and to give effect to the membership. Of course we inform you about the association, the membership, the activities we organize and the branch that is relevant to your developments. Furthermore, we use your data for other necessary aspects of the membership, such as charging the fees.*

#### **Listing affiliated companies on website**

*If you have given us your permission to enter into the membership, we will include your company information on our website. This way, potential customers can contact you via our website. These will be removed at the beginning of the year that you are no longer a member.*

#### **Commercial mailings**

*In Our newsletters, we will alert you to any third party business and services that may be of interest to your company. The mailings can therefore have a commercial content. For sending mailings with a commercial content, we ask you for your permission beforehand. Every time we send you such a mailing, you also have the possibility to let us know you do not want to receive it any longer. See the unsubscribe link at the bottom of each mailing. We also use a newsletter mailing service to send the newsletters. The personal data required to send you the newsletter are therefore passed on to this service provider. We have a legitimate interest in this transfer of your data, namely the importance of outsourcing certain activities to third parties.*

### **For board members of the Association**

*An association has board members. We collect and use the personal data of our board members to enable them to exercise their duties. The relationship between a board member and the association is an ' agreement ' In the sense of the AVG. In addition, we use their personal data to register them as a board member in the Trade register and to be able to pass on any changes to the trade register. We therefore pass on your personal data to the Chamber of Commerce. We are legally obliged to do so.*

*We will keep the personal data of the directors for the duration of 5 years after the board has been resigned.*

### **For visitors to our website**

#### *> Digital Newsletter*

*You can also subscribe to our newsletter via our website. In This newsletter we provide information about the association, membership, relevant industry developments and we will alert you to any third party business and services that may be of interest to your company. Every time we send you such a mailing, you have the possibility to let us know you know longer want to receive it. See the unsubscribe link at the bottom of each mailing. We also use a newsletter mailing service to send the newsletters. The personal data required to send you the newsletter are therefore passed on to this service provider. We have a legitimate interest in this transfer of your data, namely the importance of outsourcing certain activities to third parties.*

#### *>Cookies*

*Furthermore, our website uses cookies. Cookies are small text files that are placed on your computer, tablet or smartphone during the visit to our website. These text files store information that can be recognized by the website at a later visit.*

*We primarily place functional cookies. We do this to help our website to function. For example, remember your login details during your visit.*

*With the help of analytical cookies we can see which pages are visited and which is clicked within our website. We use Google Analytics to do this. The information that Google collects in this way is anonymised as much as possible.*

### **For other relationships**

*Collect and use of personal data that other relationships provide us because this is necessary to protect our legitimate interests. If you are a relationship of ours, we will use your information to contact you for purposes that are in the interest of our association. For example, you might want to discuss the possibility of cooperation, providing and obtaining information and maintaining our network.*

*The association regularly organises events that can also be visited by companies that are not members. If you sign up for this, we will see this as an agreement within the meaning of the AVG. The processing of your personal data is then necessary to carry out this agreement with you (inform about the event and communicate any other aspects of the agreement as possible costs).*

### **For all persons of whom we process personal data**

*We use the services of Microsoft (A.O. Windows and Office and the associated storage options for emails and other files). Microsoft Corporations Inc is based in the US. When using its services, personal data are therefore transmitted to the US. Microsoft has a Privacy Shield Certificate. This guarantees the protection of your personal data.*

*Furthermore, the Financial administration of the association is accommodated by the Koninklijke Metaalunie. Therefore, personal data are transmitted to Koninklijke Metaalunie required when invoicing.*

*Our website and email are hosted by an external party. For this reason we also transmit personal data to this party (s). When transferring your data to all the aforementioned parties, we have a legitimate interest, namely the importance of taking on certain services of third parties.*

### **Your rights**

*You have the right to ask us to view your personal data. You can also ask us to supplement your personal data or to change inaccuracies. In addition, you have the right to request to*

*delete your personal data or to limit the use of your personal data. You can also object to the collection and use of your data or to file a complaint with the authority personal data. Finally, you can ask us to obtain your personal data or replace the data to another person. To exercise your rights, please contact: H.O.
